It is a one-stop solution that provides a wide array of employment and career related services to the citizens of India. National Career Service is a vibrant platform which aims to transform and strengthen the public employment services in the country. It brings together Job Seekers, Employers, Skill Providers, Career Counsellors, Local Service Providers (LSP's), Career Centers, Placement Organizations, Households and Government Departments on a common platform through the efficient use of information technology.**

- Easy accessibility of employment services like staffing, placement and recruitment to all the stakeholders
- Enhancing employability of the workforce by providing them information on training & skilling
- Provisioning of career counselling services
- Self-help & assessment tools of capabilities & vocational guidance services to jobseekers
- Providing information related to job profiles, career paths & employers
- PAN verified institutions and rich database of job seekers
- Career planning and rich career content on over 3500 occupations across 52 sectors
- NCS has partnerships with various private organizations like Freshersworld, Monster, HireMee, etc. and the data exchange on the portal helps connecting job seekers with more number of prospective employers
- In total 170 Model Career Centres (MCCs) have been set up across the country till now
- National Career Service Centres for Differently Abled (NCSC-DA) are being run by DGE across the country
- National Career Service Centres for SCs and STs (NCSC – SCs/STs) for providing employment related training and guidance are also being run by DGE
- NCS has a multi lingual call center where the users can call the NCS Toll Free Number 1800-425-1514 for any support. The services of the call center are available from Tuesday to Sunday from 8:00 AM to 8:00 PM in seven different languages i.e. Hindi, English, Bengali, Kannada, Malayalam, Tamil and Telugu

As on 31<sup>st</sup> Aug, 2020, a total of 1,02,93,626 active jobseekers are presently registered on the NCS Portal. More than 56,800 employers are registered on the portal and the active vacancies currently available are 1, 94,246.

**National Career Service Centers for Differently Abled (NCSC-DAs)** play a multi-disciplinary role in Vocational Rehabilitation of PwDs. These centers evaluate the residual capacities of PwDs; assist them in career planning, prepare for obtaining and retaining the employment matching their socio-psychological, physical and educational abilities and also impart non-formal training in the trades that best match their strengths and weaknesses. At present 21 NCSC-DAs are actively working in different parts of the country.

## Top Functional Areas (Vacancies wise)–July’2020





An analysis has been done for Jobs posted on NCS Portal in the month of July’2020. With the objective of apprising the jobseekers of the scope of hiring in the Functional Areas of their interest, a word cloud has been drawn for the Functional areas with large manpower requirements. Above word cloud represents top functional areas under which maximum job vacancies have been posted by Employers on NCS Portal. Functional areas like Industrial Manufacturing, Metal Production; Information Technology, Education, Administrative/Back Office Activities and Marketing & Sales have been found to offer a huge scope of placements to jobseekers with around 8,000 and above job vacancies posted against them on Portal.






In Job Fair Calendar, Job fair details pop up will now show details of organizing Career Center which will help the end user in case they wish to contact the organizing Career Center

## Online Career guidance Program by Model Career Centre, Jaipur




## Online Job Fair by Model Career Center, NCSCDA, Bhubaneswar

Job Fairs are a crucial platform to help meet quick and bulk requirement of Employers and has a wider reach, hence Model Career Center, NCSCDA, Bhubaneswar organized an Online Job Fair through NCS Portal from 7<sup>th</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup> Aug, 2020 with Annapurna Finance (P) Limited for Job roles of Field Credit Officer and Desk Officer. The online Job Fair targeted candidates with 12<sup>th</sup> pass and above qualification for around 50 job vacancies and by the end of online Job Fair, around 11 candidates got shortlisted by Annapurna Finance (P) Limited for its various job roles.

## NICS, Noida organized series of Online Training Programs for Employment Officers

NICS being the nodal institute for capacity building under NCS project has been organizing trainings from time to time for various stakeholders. In August month, NICS organized two batches of 2 day Online training programs for Employment officers on 13<sup>th</sup>-14<sup>th</sup> Aug, 2020 and 20<sup>th</sup>-21<sup>st</sup> Aug, 2020. The training programs were addressed by Smt. M. L. Gautam Director I/C, NICS, Sh. R. Aswani Kumar, Joint Director, NICS and Sh. M.S Ashok Kumar, Joint Director, NICS. These programs majorly covered valuable information on the topics like “Career Opportunities post Covid-19”, “How to organize Online Job Fair on NCS portal”, “How to conduct online employability training”, “Importance of Career Counseling during COVID-19” etc.

Additionally, the Model Career Center wing of NICS, organized a valedictory session on final day of 100 hours of TCS Online Employability Training Program on 7<sup>th</sup> Aug’2020. The Center organized two career webinars in August month on 7<sup>th</sup> and 14<sup>th</sup> Aug, 2020. Both the webinars were organized in collaboration with Panimalar Institute of Technology for 12<sup>th</sup> pass, Final year Students and Jobseekers. Topic of first webinar was “Career Opportunities in Electronics & Media” and more than 30 candidates participated in it and second webinar covered detailed discussion on “Digital Transformation-Game Changing Technologies of the Future” in which around 80 candidates participated.

### **Webinar on “Careers in Aviation Sector in India” by FICCI, Model Career Center**

The session focused on the scope and opportunities in Aviation Sector both for technical and non-technical graduates and also threw light on how this sector is the most upcoming sector despite the current pandemic situation.

### **Webinar for Employers by Model Career Center, Bharuch, Gujarat**

Model Career Center, Bharuch conducted a webinar with more than 50 employers of Surat region on 11<sup>th</sup> Aug’2020. Objective of the webinar was to make the participants aware about NCS online employment services which are especially helpful at the time of COVID-19 crisis in meeting manpower requirements of Employers. Focal points of the webinar were: Employer Registration Process on NCS, Job Posting and candidates’ shortlisting Process, participation process in NCS online Job Fairs and other offline services of NCS.

## **Job Camp for migrant workers organized by Model Career Center, Muzaffarpur, Bihar**

A Job camp was organized by Model Career Centre, Muzaffarpur on 18<sup>th</sup> Aug, 2020 at its premises to connect migrant workers with job opportunity. The Job drive was organized for the role of Sales Officer for employer Bajrang Agro Pvt. Ltd. Around 50 candidates with qualification 10<sup>th</sup> pass and above appeared for the interview and around 28 candidates got shortlisted for the final round of interview.

## **Online Placement Drive organized by Model Career Center, Jalore, Rajasthan**

Model Career Center, Jalore, Rajasthan organized an online Placement Drive through NCS Portal on 18<sup>th</sup> and 19<sup>th</sup> Aug, 2020 for 10<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> pass and ITI candidates for the job roles of welder, fitter, NEEM Trainees etc . The Placement drive was organized for 3 employers namely Srivas Foundation, Jaipur; Perfect Rescue Force Pvt. Ltd and Remso Control Technologies. Around 70 candidates participated online in this Job Fair and more than 28 candidates got shortlisted for the final round of interview to be held in Sep, 2020 first week.

## **Series of Webinars by Model Career Center, Sawai Madhopur, Rajasthan**

Model Career Center, Sawai Madhopur, organized a series of 3 webinars on NCS scheme's services, on 13<sup>th</sup>, 18<sup>th</sup> and 19<sup>th</sup> Aug, 2020. These webinars covered Registration process on NCS Portal, Job application process and how to participate in NCS online job fairs and career events. # In-depth Career Information –Leather



Leather is one of the most widely traded commodities globally. The growth in demand for leather is driven by the fashion industry, especially footwear. Apart from this, furniture and interior design industries, as well as the automotive industry also demand leather.

India's leather industry has grown drastically, transforming from a mere raw material supplier to a value-added product exporter and accounts for around 12.93 per cent of the world's leather production of hides/skins. Total leather good export from India stood at US\$ 4.64 billion in 2019-20.

During April-August 2019, the major markets for Indian leather products were US (16.73 per cent), Germany (12.31 per cent), UK (11.41 per cent), Italy (7.48 per cent), and France (5.54 per cent).

During April-August 2019, products exported include leather footwear component (US\$ 115.19 million), leather garments (US\$ 190.07 million), finished leather export (US\$ 237.69 million), leather footwear (US\$ 937.13 million) and leather goods (US\$ 584.37 million).

Hence, the leather industry has a place of prominence in the Indian economy due to substantial export earnings and growth. **(Source: India Brand Equity Foundation, [www.ibef.org](http://www.ibef.org))**

Between 2017 and 2022, a total of 2.39 million additional jobs are expected to be created in the Leather Sector. This includes 0.88 million full time employees in leather manufacturing, 0.77 million workers in micro enterprises, and 0.74 million in daily wage/self-employed workers such as cobblers. With 55% of the workforce below the age of 35, the Indian leather industry has one of the youngest and most productive workforces. **(Source: Leather Sector Skill council, [www.leatherssc.org](http://www.leatherssc.org))**

### Online counselling for students, job seekers

WITH mounting mental health issues amidst the uncertainty surrounding the pandemic, the Model Career Centre (MCC) in Sambalpur is facilitating online counselling services to youths to cope with career-related anxiety.

MCC runs under National Career Services (NCS) of the Ministry of Labour and Employment (MoLE) and aims at providing career counselling, knowledge support and a host of employment-related services to the youths.

Its operations had been temporarily suspended since the lockdown in March. During this period, anxious students and job aspirants started sending emails to coordinators and counsellors seeking advice. Considering the situation at hand, the centre initiated online counselling.

It resumed online operations from third week of April and

started online counselling services through Whatsapp from April 23. As the WhatsApp forum with two dedicated counsellors received a very good response, the coordinators started conducting webinars in June. Atleast five webinars were conducted in one month with topics centering on opportunities for youth amidst the pandemic.



In-charge of MCC, Gulshan Kumar Rohilla said, "The Covid lockdown triggered anxiety among many youths who were preparing for various competitive examinations and job interviews. The unpredictability of exam schedules troubled many. As sessions in person was not feasible given the safety criteria, we went online". He added that more initiatives are in the offing to help youth cope up with this phase.

MCC has also collaborated with TCS ION recently to conduct a soft skill certificate course for job aspirants. It is likely to start soon.
